SLOW! **Slow Zone Areas**
 For your safety, these trails incorporate "slow zone areas". A slow zone area is a section of trail which will be used by all or most of the following: horse riders, cyclists, walkers, people with limited mobility. In these areas horse riders are asked to walk their horses and cyclists to ride slowly.

Direction of travel
 Also, for your safety on this shared use trail system, cyclists and walkers travel anti-clockwise while horse riders travel in a clockwise direction. All users MUST follow the direction of travel as indicated by the waymarkers – this will enable you to see oncoming users.
