Recommended Components of an Outdoor Recreation Bill

National Outdoor Recreation Forum

- **Preamble** including overarching principles to govern how the legislation is used
- Right of access on publicly owned land –
 with exemptions for operational, public safety and security reasons
- Core path networks –
 to meet the needs for all recreational users
- Permissive path agreements –
 to replace reliance on the Recreation and Youth Services Order
- Access to open country –
 to establish outdoor recreation areas on open land
- Public rights of way –
 supported by public path creation orders
- Duty of care –
 giving clarification of occupiers' liability as it applies to recreational users.
